





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Visit the only "Grand Mansion" on the River Road to be authentically restored. From the elaborate Gingerbread work, to the five hand painted ceilings, she has truly earned her place as the most opulent Plantation in the South. Influenced by Louise Von Seybold Marmillion's Bavarian Heritage. This vividly colored home is listed as a National Historic Landmark. It features an 1830's slave cabin, which includes a collection of black history documentation. An 1840's one-room schoolhouse "The Sugar Mill Pavilion" is available for corporate events, weddings, receptions and other private parties. The Plantation offers guided tours, educational field trips and Plantation Store.

## Laura: A Creole Plantation

Travel Promotion Association, Laura's "Creole Family Saga" tour details 200 years of real-life stories of owners, women, slaves & children of this sugar plantation. Guided tours based on 5,000 pages of French documents and upon Laura's own "Memories of the Old Plantation Home." Built in 1805, still surrounded by sugarcane, the farmstead stands with 12 historic buildings, gardens and the slave quarters where the west African folktales of the legendary rascal Br'er Rabbit were recorded.

The "Crown Jewel of Louisiana's River Road" awaits your arrival. Houmas House once again shines & reflects its history as once the largest sugarcane plantation in America and its owners amongst the wealthiest in the South. Extensive renovations have recently returned the Mansion to the period reflecting the Great Sugar Empire of the 1800s. The Mansion, begun in 1805, & completed by Wade Hampton II in 1828, along with the original plantation house built in the 1770s, rests among great oaks, some dating back 500 years. Come stroll through 12 acres of breathtaking gardens & enjoy the waterlily pond, fountains, sculptures, bridges and dual garçonnières. Named 2009 Louisiana's Attraction of the Year.
