Welcome to the Beach

Leave the crowds behind and find your spot on Southwest Florida's sunlit shoreline. Relax on soft golden sand, wade into calm, clear waters, and share the beach with pelicans gliding overhead or dolphins surfacing to say hello. When adventure calls, grab a snorkel, search the shore for seashells, or join the local tradition of hunting for fossilized shark teeth. Simple pleasures and endless discoveries define what beach days are meant to be.





Don Pedro Island State Park

Set out on a mini adventure to Don Pedro Island State Park, a hidden island escape waiting to be explored. Paddle out by kayak or cruise in by boat to mangrove-lined shores and wander along peaceful nature trails. Cross to the Gulf side to find a mile of soft, powdery sand and clear water, perfect for swimming, shelling, or simply soaking in the serenity.

Englewood Beach at Chadwick Park

All aboard for a beach day to remember at Englewood Beach Park. Expansive Gulf views meet soft, shell-strewn sand where fossilized shark teeth hide in plain sight. Families will love the playground and convenient amenities. Settle in for the day, then stay for a sunset worthy of a toast.



Stump Pass Beach State Park

Kick off your visit with a local tradition by placing a shell on driftwood and making a wish, then see where the day takes you. Wander the shoreline, spot playful dolphins, and feel the breeze as the water laps the shore. It is the perfect place to chase a sunset, unwind, and let your cares drift away.

Knight Island (Palm Island)

Find your own slice of paradise on this barrier island, where pristine beaches and endless Gulf views create the perfect setting. Accessible only by boat, water taxi, or car ferry, Palm Island offers a true escape. For the ultimate experience, rent a vacation home or stay at Palm Island Resort and enjoy island life at its best: no traffic, no crowds, no worries—just pristine beaches and zero regrets.

Gasparilla Island State Park

Combine relaxing on the beach with exploring history. Walk along an expansive, dune-lined shoreline, then visit the famous Port Boca Grande Lighthouse, which houses a museum showcasing the island’s vibrant history. Along the way, enjoy sweeping Gulf views and watch for dolphins just offshore. It offers the perfect mix of natural beauty and cultural charm, all in one memorable stop.

The water is calling, and adventure is waiting! Paddle through peaceful mangroves, dive in for a refreshing swim, or reel in the day's catch at one of Florida's top fishing spots. Seasoned boater or first-timer, you can rent a boat or let a captain steer the way on a scenic cruise. Watch dolphins play, soak up golden sunsets, and make memories you'll cherish long after the tide goes out.



Plan Your Beach Day

Sea Turtle Nesting Season

From May through October, our beaches serve as nurseries for sea turtles. During this special time, it's essential to help protect them. Respect all marked nests and never touch or disturb them. Keep lights dim at night, as artificial lighting can disorient hatchlings. Before leaving the beach, fill in holes and smooth out sandcastles so tiny turtles won't get trapped. Always take your trash with you to prevent hazards for sea life, and if you're lucky enough to see a turtle, enjoy the moment quietly from a distance. Every small effort helps these incredible creatures reach the Gulf safely.

Beach Etiquette 101

A perfect beach day isn't just about having fun in the sun, it's about keeping our shores beautiful for everyone (and everything) that calls them home. Please remember:

Sea Turtle Nests: Watch for marked areas and give them space.

Leave No Trace: Carry out everything you bring, including trash and recycling.

Keep It Peaceful: Be mindful of music and noise so all visitors can relax.

Respect Wildlife: Admire dolphins, seabirds, manatees, and other creatures from a distance.

A little care can go a long way in preserving our coast for future generations.

Cruise It

Ready to conquer the waves? Rent a motorboat, sailboat, or jet ski and head out on the water. Our marinas make it easy with quick how-tos, safety tips, and local expertise. Bringing your own boat? They'll direct you to the best launch ramps, trailer parking, and fuel docks, plus share insider routes to smooth water. Comfortable, confident, and cruising—just the way you like it!



Paddle It

Explore the Blueway Trails, which are nearly 200 miles of paddling-friendly routes. Drift along freshwater rivers and creeks or follow the saltwater shoreline by kayak, canoe, or stand-up paddleboard. Expect wildlife sightings, mangrove tunnels, and expansive sky views you'll talk about long after you dock.



Tour It

Set sail for adventure. Take a sailing lesson with an experienced instructor, navigating peaceful waters and open bays. Prefer to relax? Hop aboard a narrated cruise with King Fisher Fleet in Punta Gorda and let the crew handle the navigation. Drop anchor at a hidden island, watch dolphins surf the wake, and stay awhile as the sun sinks below the horizon. With skilled skippers and carefully planned routes, unforgettable journeys await.

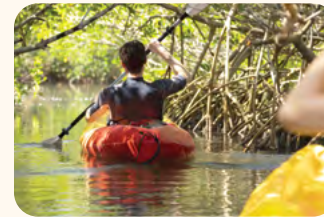
DAY 1 | Lines In, Spirits Up

Kick off with a charter launching from Lashley Park Municipal Marina to reel in snook, tarpon, and snapper. End the day with cold brews, live music, and harbor views at TT's Tiki Bar.



DAY 2 | Tees and Taps

Play a round at Riverwood Golf Club or Heritage Landing, then enjoy local drinks at Peace River Beer Company or darts and brews at IceHouse Pub.



DAY 3 | Paddle and Play

Kayak along one of the Charlotte Harbor Blueway Trails, spotting dolphins and manatees. Refuel with waterfront bites and live music at Lighthouse Grill and Tiki Bar, a local favorite.



DAY 4 | Speed and Sunsets

Rent jet skis or try parasailing over the Gulf. Enjoy rooftop cocktails and laid-back nightlife in downtown Punta Gorda as the sun dips low.



DAY 5 | Chill and Cheers

Enjoy brunch at Leroy's Southern Kitchen & Bar, browse Fishermen's Village, and savor one last waterfront view before heading home.

Tarpon bite year-round, but April through October is the peak time to check off this bucket-list catch (and release) in memorable fashion.

From rods, reels, and tackle to bait and coolers, you'll find everything you need for a great day of casting. Want to focus on having fun? Rent a fully equipped boat or book with a local captain who will provide all the essentials and insider tips to land the big one. Your perfect fishing trip is always within reach with convenient marinas and rental shops throughout the area.



Hooked on Charlotte Harbor

Whether it's your first cast or your hundredth, fishing here feels personal. Charlotte Harbor offers it all: saltwater, back-bay, offshore, and pier action where Gulf waters meet the Peace, Myakka, and Caloosahatchee rivers.

Is freshwater more your style? Explore numerous lakes across the county, including the Babcock/Webb Wildlife Management Area, with fishable ponds, canals, and easy access points.

Beginners can start from convenient piers and parks, while seasoned anglers sight-cast the flats, work the mangroves, or run offshore for bigger bites. Friendly guides, well-stocked marinas, and nearby launch ramps make it easy to get on the water, with bait, tackle, and local tips available.

Snook

Hug the mangroves and beaches and work the tide for this local favorite.



Redfish

Look for tails in the shallows; they love to cruise the flats and around oyster bars.



Spotted Sea Trout

Cast over grass beds with a popping cork for steady action.



Grouper

Head offshore, drop deep, and prepare for a tug-of-war.



Tarpon

Go big or go home! Hook the Silver King during migration season for an unforgettable fight.



PEDALS, PADDLES & FOOTPRINTS

Explore over 70 parks, preserves, and recreation areas, from Gulf-side paths on Manasota Key to pine-flatwoods routes in the south. Hike and bike through tropical landscapes, observe wildlife along the Great Florida Birding Trail, and connect to 50+ Blueway paddling trails for a land-to-water adventure. Prefer an in-town stroll? Walk along harbor-front promenades and through historic neighborhoods filled with colorful murals, cafes, and shops.



Birdwatching Bliss

Punta Gorda/Englewood Beach is a standout destination along the Great Florida Birding Trail, offering an exceptional blend of coastal estuaries, mangrove forests, prairies, and pine flatwoods that support an impressive diversity of species. Spot everything from iconic wading birds like herons, egrets, and roseate spoonbills to raptors such as ospreys and bald eagles, along with seasonal migratory warblers and other songbirds. Whether you're an experienced birder or simply enjoy wildlife watching, the area's protected natural areas and peaceful waters create the perfect setting for discovering Florida's vibrant birdlife.

Cycle & See the Sights

Explore Punta Gorda/Englewood Beach on two wheels to see why it's one of Florida's most bike-friendly destinations. The Cape Haze Pioneer Trail runs 8 miles along an old rail line, crossing scenic creeks and mangrove habitats where ospreys, herons, and spoonbills often appear. From there, cyclists can connect to the Boca Grande Bike Path, adding another 6 miles of island views and coastal breezes. In downtown Punta Gorda, the Harborwalk and Linear Park Trail link waterfront parks, neighborhoods, and Fishermen's Village, while multi-use paths across the city make it easy to ride, explore, and enjoy the sunshine—no car needed.



Loaner Bikes, Limitless Fun!

Prefer pavement with your waterfront views? Punta Gorda's free bike loaner program makes it easy to roll. Check out a bike at pickup spots along the Harborwalk, then follow planned routes through this charming, harborside town. Whether you ride dirt or cruise downtown, adventure awaits. Cost: \$0. Fun: unlimited.

Hobnob with "the Locals"

Ready to meet the area's natives? Start at Peace River Wildlife Center, a rescue and rehab sanctuary where you can get up close with native birds. Or check out Iguanaland to see reptiles and learn about them. Then go on a Babcock Ranch Eco-Tour, traveling through ranchlands and swamps to see alligators, deer, cracker cattle and wild turkeys.



What You Might See - Keep your eyes open for bald eagles, owls, pelicans overhead, alligators cruising the shallows, and deer or wild turkeys moving through the pines. Look closer, and you'll spot turtles sunning on logs, along with butterflies and wading birds dancing across the marsh.

Good to Know - Bring binoculars and a camera, wear comfortable closed-toe shoes, and maintain a respectful distance from wildlife. Pack water and reef-safe sunscreen. Say hello, take a picture, and leave only footprints—the locals appreciate it.

PUNTA GORDA

Where Creativity Meets the Coast

In Punta Gorda, culture isn't hidden behind velvet ropes. It spills into gardens, flows into concert halls, and welcomes visitors through studio doorways left open to the breeze. A morning could begin at the Peace River Botanical & Sculpture Gardens, where modern artworks emerge from palms and water as the light changes them hour by hour.

Music gives the town its pulse. Discover your rhythm at the Charlotte Performing Arts Center, home to performances by The Charlotte Chorale, Florida Philharmonic, Gulfshore Opera, and more. Be sure to visit the Gulf Theater at the Military Heritage Museum as well.



Across town, the Visual Arts Center anchors the scene with three galleries featuring rotating exhibitions. You might stop for a quick look and leave with something unique wrapped in brown paper from the gift shop. Nearby, the Artisan Atelier buzzes with working studios and a gallery showcasing what local artists are creating. Be sure to check out the Sea Grape Gallery, a cooperative fine-art space with award-winning artists and unique gifts.

History is also nearby. Pay respects at the Vietnam Wall of Southwest Florida, then visit the Blanchard House Museum, the Punta Gorda Historic Railroad Depot, and the History Park & Artisan Village. Do not miss the Military Heritage Museum, where flight simulators, immersive exhibits, and veteran guides bring stories of service to life, creating an unforgettable, educational experience.





GULF ISLANDS

Island Escapes & Coastal Charm

Once known as Knight/Palm, Don Pedro, and Little Gasparilla, these three islands have gradually merged into a single continuous landmass—yet each retains its own unique character. Surrounded by 12 miles of calm, silky-sand beaches, the Gulf Islands serve as a sanctuary of natural beauty. Here, wildlife far outnumbers the people, creating a place where peace, quiet, and pure relaxation come naturally.



PORT CHARLOTTE

A Hub of Culture, Food, and Fun

On the north side of Charlotte Harbor, Port Charlotte welcomes visitors with excellent golf, dining, entertainment, and friendly charm. Visit The Grape Winery & Wine Bar for lively karaoke nights, delicious wines by the glass, and a relaxed, lounge-style vibe. Dinner is paired with entertainment at places like Visani Italian Steakhouse and Comedy Theater, The Grill at 1951, and Donato's Italian Restaurant, where music and good food come together.

The Twisted Fork Restaurant® and Bar, located next to Bert's Black Widow Harley-Davidson®, is a popular place featuring live music on Bert's Back Porch every weekend, bike nights, and special events. For something different, the Bean Depot Café & Museum offers a unique live music experience. Theater fans should check out a performance by the Charlotte Players, the area's vibrant community theater group.

Recently opened, Sunseeker Resort Florida Gulf Coast, Curio by Hilton, offers stunning waterfront views, a variety of dining and bar options, a full-service spa, championship golf, and spacious venues for weddings, reunions, and events.

Get your taste buds ready

Welcome to Florida's Flavor Coast, where every bite is as memorable as the views. From fresh Gulf seafood and innovative coastal dishes to international cuisines and chef-inspired menus, the culinary scene here satisfies every craving. Unique restaurants, award-winning chefs, and sunset views make each meal special. Come hungry, stay late, and enjoy what's uniquely ours.

Seafood Sensations

Fresh Gulf flavors have always been part of life here. Long before restaurants lined the harbor, local fishermen hauled in grouper, mullet, and blue crab from these waters, supplying markets and families across Southwest Florida. Today, that tradition continues in every bite. At Farlow's on the Water, Gulf catches meet Caribbean flair with blackened mahi, coconut shrimp, and island-inspired sauces served in a breezy waterfront setting.

Laishley Crab House pairs Peace River views with seasonal stone crab, shrimp, and grouper that shine at sunset. For true Old Florida flavor, Peace River Seafood serves blue crab by the bucket, rich She-Crab soup, and just-caught dishes in a relaxed, coastal atmosphere. And at Ortigia Cucina & Bar, diners can savor authentic Italian seafood classics made with local seafood in an open-air downtown setting. The menu is inspired by the beauty and flavors of the small town in Sicily that the chef is from.



Italian & Pizza

Donato's is known for house-made pastas, classic red-sauce dishes, and a warm, family-friendly vibe. Nearby, Monty's specializes in homemade-style Italian meals with hearty pastas and garlic knots that vanish quickly. Both are great options for a comforting dinner after a day on the water.



Burgers & BBQ

At TT's Tiki Bar, the relaxed, toes-in-the-sand vibe features hearty burgers, live music, and stunning views of Charlotte Harbor. Burg'r Bar takes comfort food up a notch with gourmet burgers piled high with creative toppings and a laid-back coastal atmosphere. Lighthouse Grill & Tiki Bar delivers amazing smoked wings, brisket, and ribs alongside breezy water views and tropical cocktails. Texas Best Barbecue rounds out the lineup with tender, slow-cooked meats and signature house-made sauces that keep guests coming back for more. Around here, great food always comes with a side of sunshine and a view.

A Taste of Tradition: Gulf Grouper Sandwiches

Before Punta Gorda/Englewood Beach became favorite coastal getaways, local fishermen were hauling in fresh grouper straight from the Gulf. These firm, flavorful fillets became a local staple—grilled on docks, fried at fish fries, and served in seaside shacks along Charlotte Harbor. To this day, the grouper sandwich remains one of Southwest Florida’s most beloved bites, symbolizing the simple joy of fresh-from-the-boat dining.



RECIPE CARD

TWISTED SPROUTS

Sautéed Brussels Sprouts with Bacon & Almonds Over Goat Cheese
Signature Dish at The Twisted Fork!

INGREDIENTS

- 1½–2 lbs Brussels Sprouts, Halved
- 2–3 tbsp Olive Oil
- 1–2 cloves Garlic, Minced
- ½ tsp Smoked Paprika
- Salt & Pepper
- 6–8 slices Thick-Cut Bacon, Cooked and Chopped
- 1 cup Sliced Almonds
- Avocado Oil (or any cooking oil)

Goat Cheese Spread

- 8 oz Goat Cheese
- Splash of White Wine
- 1 tsp Chopped Rosemary
- Pinch of Salt
- A Little Heavy Cream



Heat the oven to 350°F, then toss the halved Brussels sprouts with olive oil, garlic, paprika, salt, and pepper, spread them on a parchment-lined sheet pan, and bake for about 14 minutes before letting them cool. While they rest, toast the almonds on a pan until lightly golden. Mix the goat cheese with a splash of white wine, rosemary, and salt, then add heavy cream until it becomes spreadable and chill the mixture. In a hot, oiled pan, sauté the cooled sprouts with the chopped bacon until they’re heated through and lightly charred. To serve, spread a spoonful of the goat cheese on each plate, top with the hot sprouts and bacon, and finish with toasted almonds and a sprinkle of parsley.

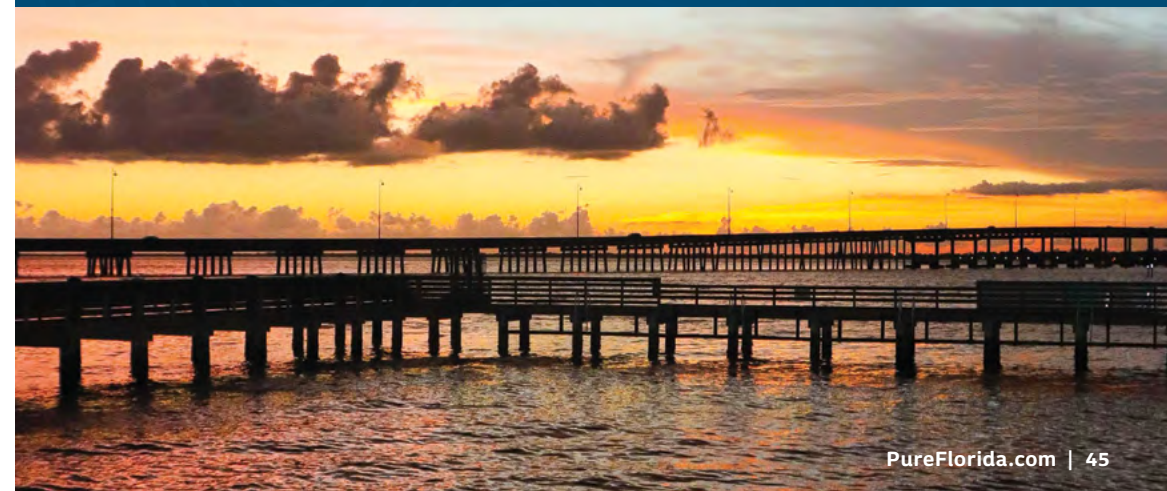

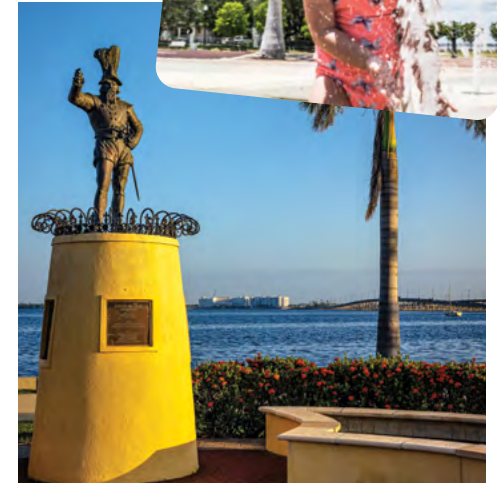

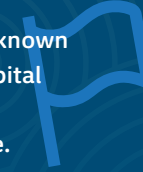

Beachcombing Morning: Spend the morning on Manasota Key, where the whole family can hunt for prehistoric shark teeth hidden in the sand.

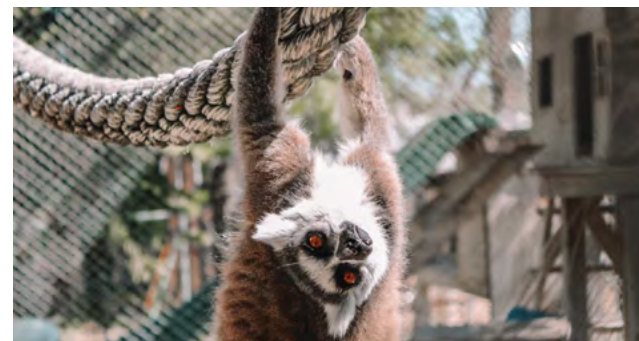
