Day One

Itinerary

Day One - Las Vegas - Kodachrome Basin State Park

Drive to Cedar Breaks National Monument, for a high-elevation preview hike. In the afternoon, arrive at Kodachrome Basin State Park and get acquainted with the camp.

Day Two - Explore Grand Staircase - Escalante National Monument

Today you head into the wild expanse of Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument where you will hike 5-8 miles along the Escalante River's clear flowing waters and canyon walls.

Day Three - Explore Bryce Canyon National Park - Drive to Zion National Park

After breakfast, head to Bryce Canyon National Park. Hike down into the canyon to the mouth of the Bryce amphitheatre. After your hike, hop in the van and make your way to Zion National Park.

Day Four - Zion National Park

Embark on a hike to the observation point for an incredible view of Zion Canyon. In the afternoon, explore the world-famous Zion Narrows. On this hike you will wade through the knee- to waist-deep water of the Virgin River.

Day Five - Zion - Las Vegas

After breakfast, head into Zion National Park for a finale hike to Angel's Landing! The hike leads to sweeping north-south views of the Virgin River Gorge, Cathedral Mountain, Observation Point, Cable Mountain and the Great White Throne looming high above Angel's Landing. In the afternoon, you'll return to Las Vegas.

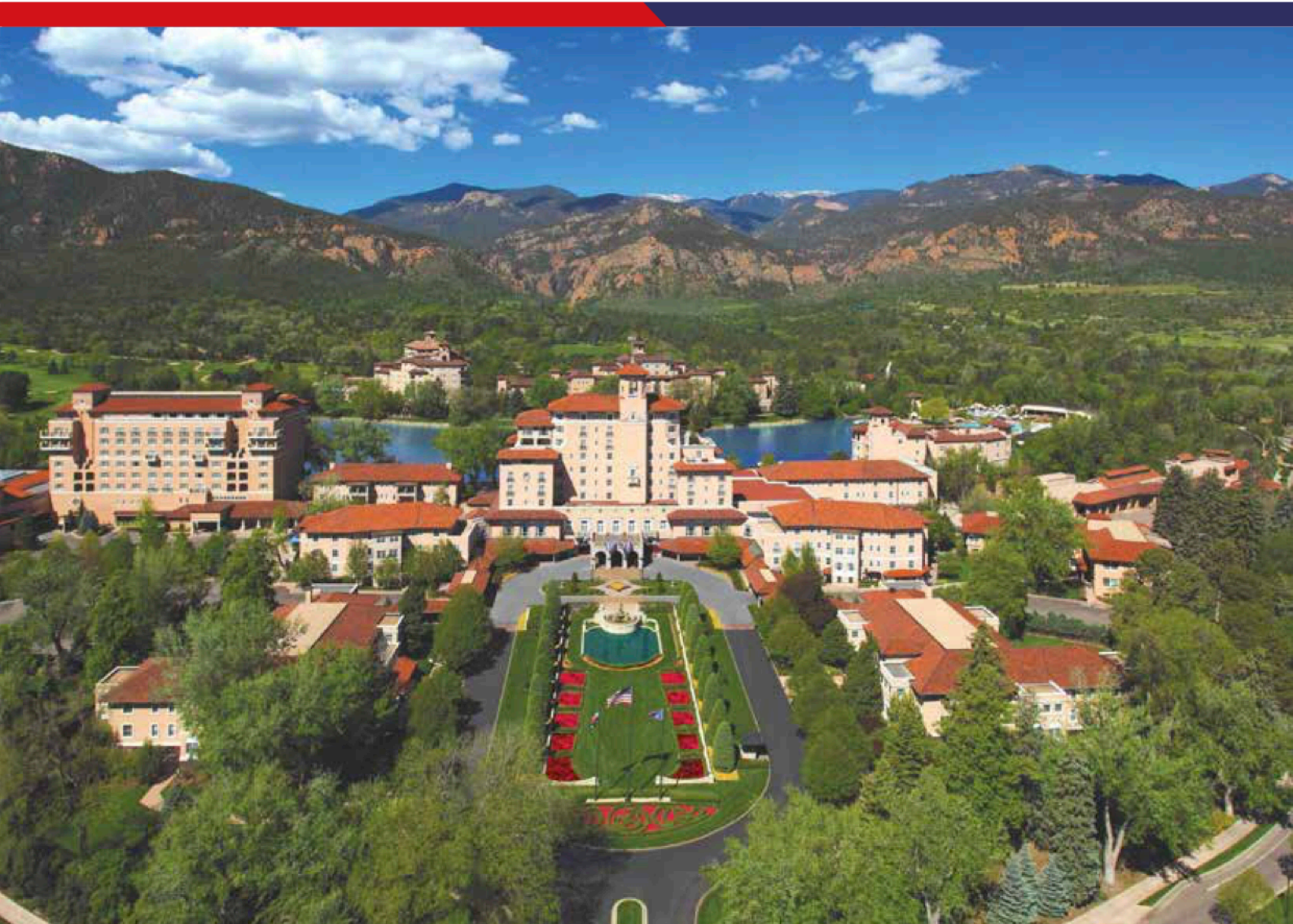
Day Eight

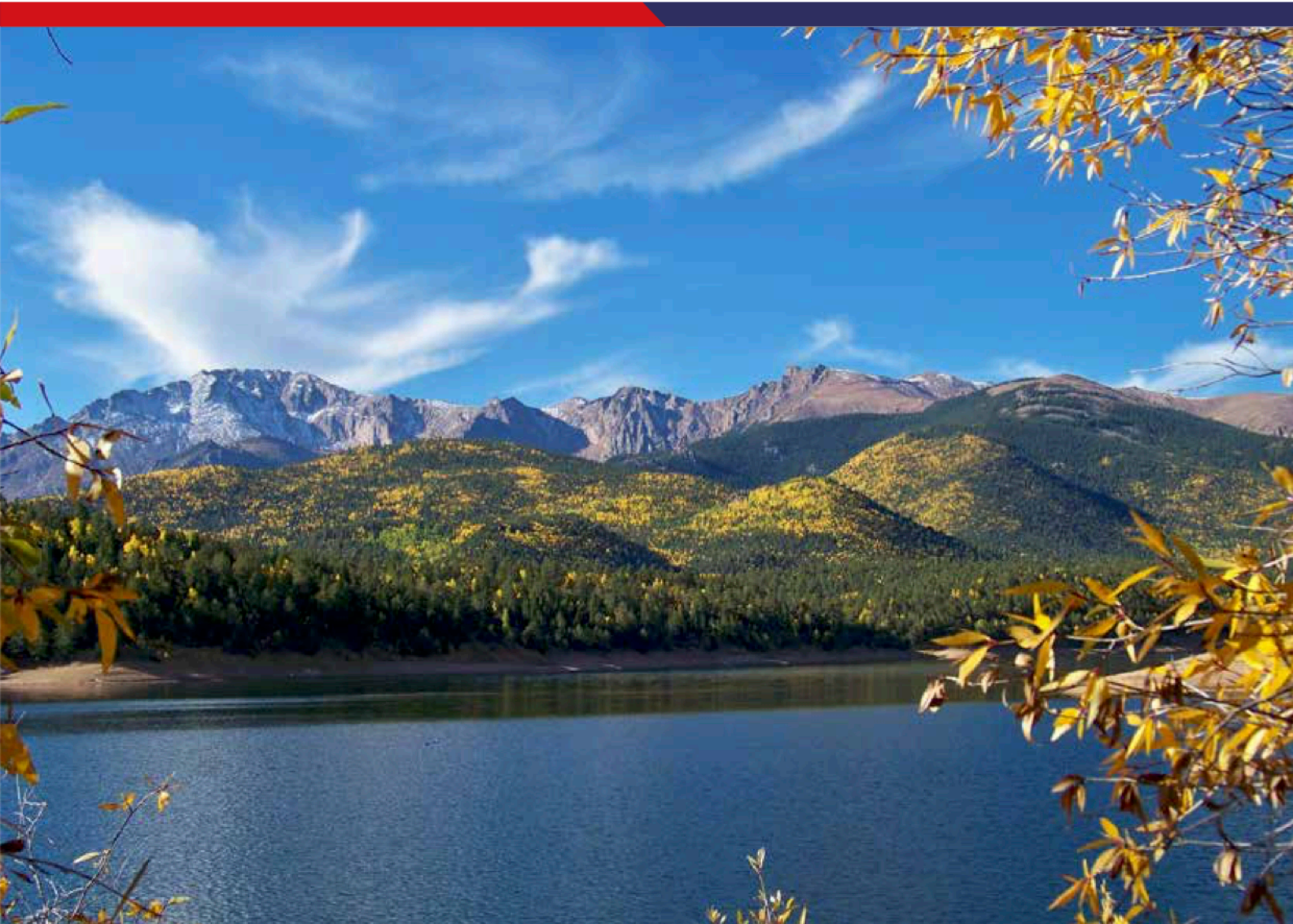

This intensive fieldbased photography workshop will focus on finding, and safely photographing, Greater Yellowstone's abundant wildlife.

Itinerary

Day One - The first morning will include a field orientation to the best camera settings, framing, and tricks to creating great wildlife and landscape images. In the afternoon, you will explore Elk Ranch before heading further north into prime grizzly habitat.
(Breakfast, Lunch included)

Day Two - Wake early to photograph the sunrise on the Teton and early morning wildlife. You will then explore lesser travelled roads in Northern Jackson Hole in search of wildlife before returning to the lodge. You will then return to the field for more great photography opportunities in the softer light of late afternoon and evening.
(Breakfast, Lunch included)

Day Three - The early morning will be spent tracking bears, photographing classic landscapes and looking for other wildlife in Grand Teton National Park. You will then travel north into Yellowstone National Park and make your way to the Lamar Valley, often called the Serengeti of North America. This is the single best wildlife photography area in Yellowstone and known for its abundance of grizzlies and wolves.
(Breakfast, Lunch included)

Day Four - In the early morning, time will be spent tracking wolves with plenty of time to photograph the magnificent landscape and vistas of this dramatic part of Yellowstone. The rest of the day will be spent exploring the northern Yellowstone region before you return to Lamar Valley for an evening of bear, wolf and wildlife photography in Lamar and Slough Creek.

Day Five - Another early morning will give you one last chance to photograph the wolves of the Lamar Valley before beginning to head back to Jackson Hole via the interior of Yellowstone. This will give you time to explore and photograph more classic Yellowstone places including the Upper, Middle and Lower Geyser Basins and an eruption of Old Faithful. The tour will finish with a group dinner in Jackson Hole where you can relive your tour memories.

Itinerary

Day One - West Yellowstone

Our journey to the trailhead at Yellowstone South Entrance takes us to West Thumb Geyser Basin, where sightings of eagles, swans and coyotes are possible. The night finds us in West Yellowstone.

Day Two - Gardiner, MT

Before leaving West Yellowstone, we will stop by the Wolf Discovery Centre. Then our journey takes us North visiting some of the 10,000 thermal features of the Park, including areas such as Madison River Valley, Firehole Drive, Gibbon Falls, Sheep Eaters Cliff, and Golden Gate. The night finds us in Gardiner, MT.

Day Three - Moran, WY

We complete the lower loop, riding through Hayden Valley, a common winter range for bison and wolves. The highlight of the day is the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. Here the scenery (including Yellowstone Falls) is absolutely stunning. Our journey returns us to the South Entrance, where we will head to Turpin Meadows Ranch for the night.

Day Four - Moran, WY or Brooks Lake Lodge

The next 3 nights, you will stay at a mountain lodge in the heart of the backcountry. Today is play time, snowmobiling the famous powder atop the high plateau of Union Pass - the perfect place to test your new skills.

Day Five - Moran, WY or Brooks Lake Lodge

After a hearty breakfast you'll head back to the backcountry for some more fun! The night finds you back at the lodge.

Day Six - Jackson, WY

After several days of adventure this will be your last day on your snowmobile! The night finds you back in Jackson, reminiscing about your adventure.

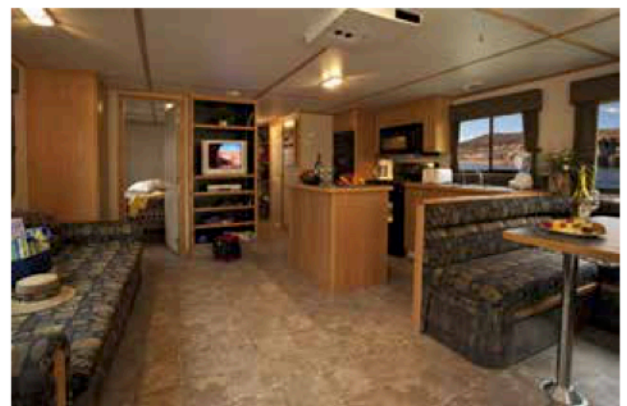
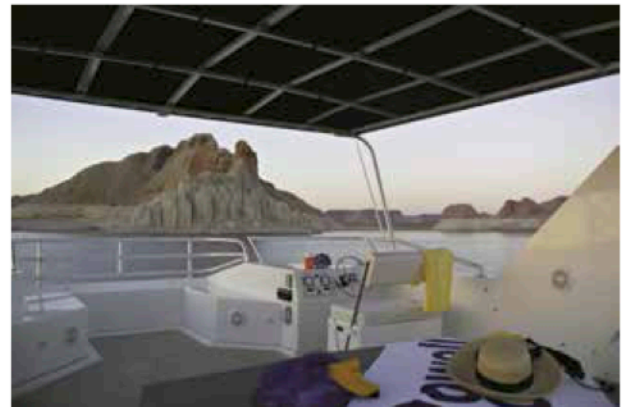
