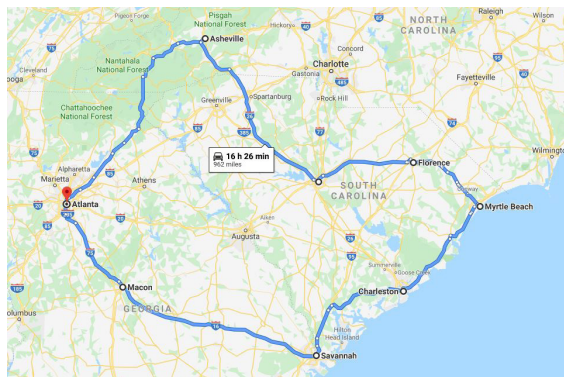

••• ITINERARY HIGHLIGHT •••

Arrive in Atlanta, tour Atlanta, GA, Asheville, NC, Myrtle Beach, SC, Charleston, SC, Savannah, GA; return to Atlanta. The Southeast region of the USA has many old, beautiful cities each with their own special interests, attractions, history and charm. This itinerary covers most fascinating tour places and appealing cities from the Appalachian Mountains to the Atlantic Coast. You will see natural beauties, sceneries, and also experience the “Southern” culture, history, food, music, warmth and hospitality.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 - ATLANTA

Arrive in Atlanta, GA

Visit **Stone Mountain Park Skyline*** - the largest one piece of granite explored on the surface of the planet. Ride the cable car to a historic, carved peak.

Martin Luther King Center – a National Historic site. King’s birth home, **Ebenezer Baptist Church** & his final resting place.

Other: CNN Headquarters, Margaret Mitchell House



DAY 2 - ATLANTA

Located south of the Appalachian mountains. The center for Southeastern economy, it is the capital city of Georgia. 20 Fortune 500 company headquarters are located here. ‘Gone with the Wind’ was written here, Martin Luther King was born here, and the civil war movement took place here. The 1996 Olympics in Atlanta altered the city’s demographics, politics, and culture.

Tour World of Coca-Cola

This museum showcases the history of the Coca-Cola company and contains a host of entertainment and attractions.



DAY 3 - ATLANTA/ASHEVILLE, NC

Drive to Asheville through part of the Appalachian Mountain road. From Atlanta to Asheville, we will go past forestry, rivers, falls, villages, and fields. Stops will be made at scenic points and mountain villages.



DAY 4 - ASHEVILLE – TOUR OF ASHEVILLE

Asheville, NC permeated the Appalachian charm and Civilian culture. It was the ideal vacation place for rich men and literates in early years. An actual example was the Biltmore Estate build by millionaire George W. Vanderbilt. Now, the **Biltmore Village** is open to public so we will fortunately see the largest single privately owned house in the United States.

Tour Biltmore Estate

The village and gardens cover 28.5 sq.km, the home itself is 12,568 sq. meters, with 250 rooms. Wine tasting will be offered in its winery during the tour.

Tour Asheville downtown



DAY 5 - ASHEVILLE/MYRTLE BEACH

Drive to the **Myrtle Beach** area - 5 hour duration.

Arrive in Myrtle Beach and explore many entertainment options, like **Broadway at the Beach**, home of the **Ripley’s Aquarium**, featuring a brand new Penguin exhibit, or **Barefoot Landing**, a unique shopping and entertainment complex. Be sure to catch an evening performance at one of our seven live theaters. Enjoy dinner at one of Myrtle Beach’s many oceanfront restaurants.



DAY 6 - MYRTLE BEACH

Enjoy the sunshine, white beach and local activities. Myrtle Beach will surely make you enchanted by the colorful sea and soft sand under the beautiful clouds and sunshine.

Go to local restaurant for lunch

Tour Brookgreen Gardens in Murrells Inlet.

Founded in 1931, Brookgreen Gardens is America's premier gardens and wild life preserve, showcasing the largest outdoor exhibit of American Sculpture art, and one of a few select places in the US to have earned many accreditations. It is also a National Historic Landmark and attraction for all visitors of all ages.

DAY 8 - MYRTLE BEACH/CHARLESTON, SC

After breakfast: drive 2 hours to Charleston, SC. On the way, tour **Hopsewee Plantation** in Georgetown, SC.

Hopsewee Plantation was built in 1740, was one of the South's major rice plantations and the birthplace of Thomas Lynch, Jr. one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence of America. A remarkable place to see.

Established in 1670, Charleston was one of the 5 oldest big cities in the USA. Here launched the Civil War by seizing the Arsenal, Castle Pinckney and Ford Sumter from their federal garrisons. Charleston was a sister city with Boston, from where the rich people came for the warm weather in winter and rich Charleston people went to Boston for cooler summer. The historic buildings and streets are well preserved in Charleston.

Afternoon tour of Magnolia Plantation*.

Magnolia Plantation is on the National Register of Historic Places. It will show you all periods of American history in the South. The Gardens are listed as the most beautiful in the USA.

DAY 9 - CHARLESTON/SAVANNAH, GA

After **tour of Charleston**, drive 2 hours to **Savannah, GA** and take a morning tour of historical buildings on King St. and Queen St; Waterfront residential area, Old Market area and business area. Afternoon tour **USS Yorktown Museum*** drive to Savannah, enjoy dinner, then drive to hotel.

DAY 10 - SAVANNAH – TOUR SAVANNAH FULL DAY

Savannah is located on the Atlantic thousand island coast, on the bank of the Savannah River. Established in 1733 – it is the oldest city in the State of Georgia and was the old capital city of Georgia. Original designers planned the city as Heaven according to the Bible. Its' 22 park-like squares is one of the largest National Historic Landmarks in the USA. The famous film 'Forrest Gump' was produced here.

Take a morning walking tour of **River Street and Historic District**. In the afternoon, take **Dolphin Magic Boat Tour**

DAY 11 - SAVANNAH/MACON/ATLANTA

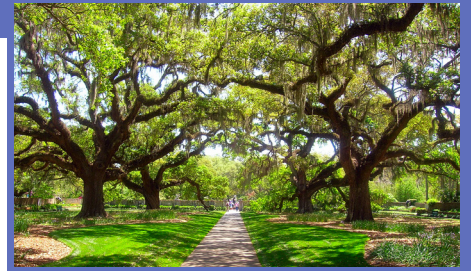
Drive from Savannah to Atlanta, stop and tour **Macon, GA**, one of the oldest cities in Georgia. Drive to Atlanta, stop at Macon after 2.5 hour drive.

Tour in Macon: Wesleyan College and Ocmulgee National Monument

After lunch, continue to Atlanta, stop at **Locust Grove Tanger Outlets shopping mall**. Dinner then drive to hotel.

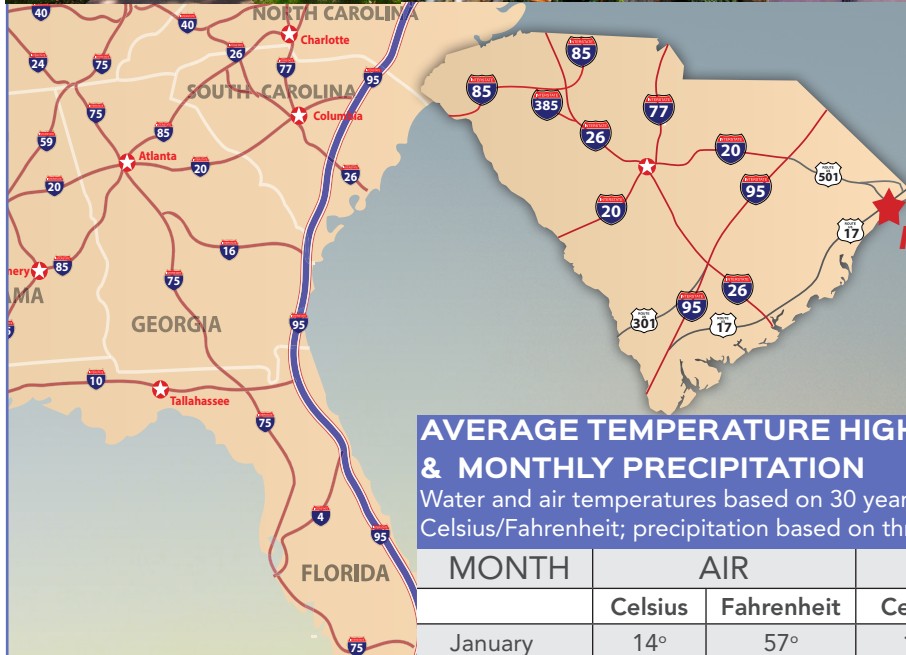
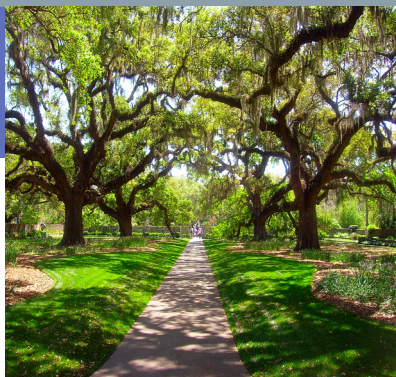
DAY 12 - ATLANTA
